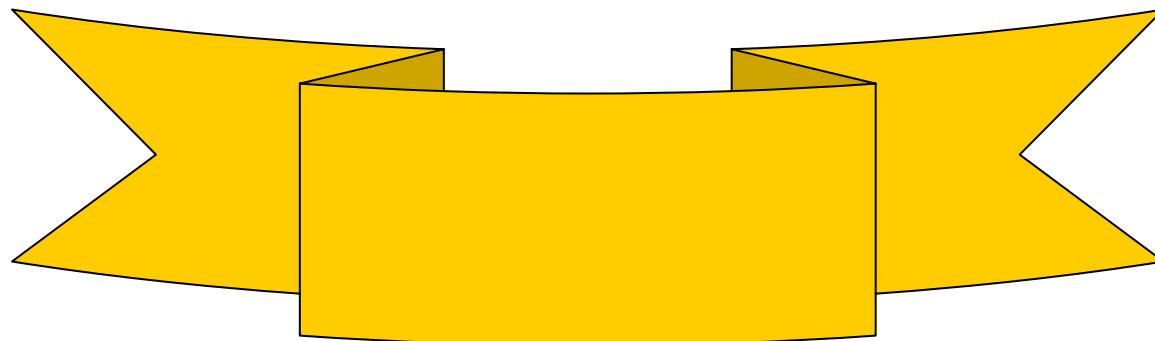

President's Message

We began 2011 with a wonderful meeting on Thursday, January 20. Attendance was great, with many of our winter members in town and 24 visitors. We enjoyed a great presentation by Joan Shay that had many members purchasing her patterns, kits, and supplies. It also encouraged more people to take Friday's workshop, for a full class of 23.

Our guild is very fortunate to bring in wonderful speakers and teachers for our general meeting and workshops. This is possible because of the funds we raise through our bi-annual quilt show. Our next show is in March 2012 and Carol Lee is our chair. It is very important that someone volunteer to serve as Carol's co-chair. This person handles the financials for the 2012 show, learns what is involved in organizing the show, and then serves as chair for the next show (2014). We will not be able to hold a show in 2014 without a chair. If we do not hold a show in 2014, we will not be able to continue offering the types of programs we currently do. Expenses for our programs and workshops total \$13,825 or 55% of our proposed 2011 expense budget. Won't someone please step forward and volunteer to co-chair the 2012 show (and chair the 2014 show)? We are also still seeking volunteers for 2012 boutique and raffle quilt chairs. Please contact me or Carol Lee if you are willing to serve in one of these roles.

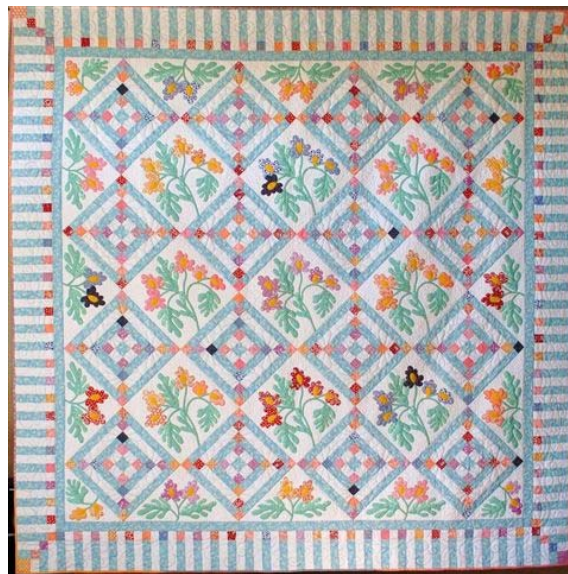
Our Prize Quilt is also on display, and we are actively selling tickets. This is our main source for ticket sales outside of each member's donation.

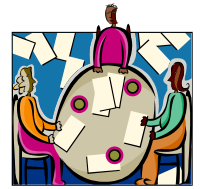
Welcome Frieda Anderson in March with her Lecture, "Trumpeting Spring" and her "Flower Patterns" Workshop. How timely!

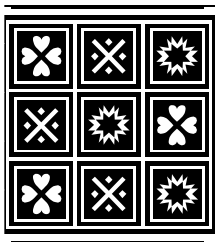
