## Community Service Update:

As of June we'd completed 35 youth quilts and 32 adult in addition to the 49 quilts we already distributed this year and 8 'special quilts' that we will keep for special purposes like auctions or scholarship. Between the quilts delivered at the Guild meeting and those completed or brought in at the June CS Bee, we completed another 20 – some still need labels. That's a grand total of 87 still at QPS and around 144 completed this year.

We plan to hold a July Bee on Tuesday, July 19th and then take off for the month of August.

When we come back in September we'll have 3 more months to get ready for our holiday donations. I'd like to have around 120 quilts to give away so we need to create about 50 more between now and the end of November. At the rate everyone has been working this is certainly an attainable goal.

Thanks again to everyone for all of their time and efforts to make these beautiful quilts for a very worthy cause.

## WISE WORDS FROM MOTHER SUPERIOR

We often are asked, "How much thread it takes to quilt a quilt?" It depends on the size of the quilt and the type of quilting to be done. Everyone's technique is different so the following are only averages. Of course it is possible to use much more or much less thread. These numbers are for the top thread only.

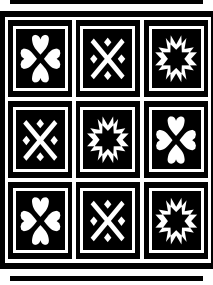
..... **Light Quilting . Medium Quilting . Heavy Quilting**

Lap/Crib Size 200 yds. .... .400 yds. .... . 600 yds.

Twin Size 400 yds. .... .800 yds. .... .1,200 yds.

Queen Size 600 yds. .... . 1,000 yds. .... .1,600 yds.

King Size 800 yds. .... .1,400 yds. .... .2,000 yds.
