Threads at Play

June 17, 2011 at 9am to 4pm

In this one-day version of Filament Fantasy, the student will jump right into doing appliqué, reverse appliqué, using decorative threads and decorative stitches, two threads through the same needle, using fused painted webbing and foil, doing cutwork and free motion embroidery on Solvy, and experimenting with various other techniques. This is a fast-paced workshop for the adventurous at heart, more of a process than a product class, and some techniques will be demonstrated only. Kit fee is \$10.00.

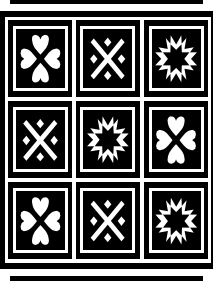
Classified
